### Report:

The meeting was opened at 16:00 h on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> December 2012 by the Coordinator of the project Prof. Dr.-Ing. Vojislav Miltenović. The venue of the meeting was the Senate Hall of the University of Nis. Coordinator of the project opened the meeting, introduced participants with meeting Agenda, and invited presenter Dr.-Ing. Aleksandar Miltenović to present the first topic of the meeting – Project management.

After the break, Coordinator called Dr.-Ing. Aleksandar Miltenović to start the presentation about Project academic issues. The presenter started with the Work Package 1. He presented goal, target group of this work package and the planned budget for its realization. Also, he listed planned activities in frame of this work package, as well as the work plan. For every activity, he explained duties and obligations of participants as well as the expected outcomes for each activity. The Coordinator opened discussion. Discussion was about institutional support for introduction of new

curriculum. After discussion, the Coordinator thanked on presentation and called the presenter to start the second topic of the meeting.

Dr.-Ing. Aleksandar Miltenović started the second presentation about Work Package 2. The presenter presented goal, target group of this work package and the budget for its realization. He accentuated that amount of budget in this work package includes equipment costs. Dr.-Ing. Aleskandar Miltenović presented planned activities in frame of this work package as well as the Work Package work plan. Project consortium planned collaborative preparation and publishing of new textbooks and authorised lectures. After the presentation, the Coordinator opened discussion about the second Work Package. After short discussion about WP managers responsibilities, Prof. Dr.-Ing. Vojislav Miltenović closed the topic and called Dipl.-Ing. Milan Banić to open the third topic.

Dipl.-Ing. Milan Banić started with the third presentation about Work Package 3. He presented goal and target group of this WP, as well as the budget for its realization. After that, planned activities in frame of this work package are presented and explained, as well as their position in the work plan. He explained how courses should be realised, generating new products and ideas for regional industry. He reminded present participants that main idea of WP 3 is to design course which could be financed by Ministry of labour for and by industry subjects. Dipl.-Ing. Milan Banić explained the principle of development projects for industry performed at Karlsruhe Institute of Technology. M.Sc. Markus Blust gave further explanation and clarification about the realisation of development projects. Prof. Dr.-Ing. Vojislav Miltenović opened the discussion. Doc. Dr.-Ing. Biljana Marković asked for additional explanation about design and implementation of the courses. Coordinator explained that all universities will be involved in process of design and implementation of courses, but they should be defined depending of needs of each university and surrounding industry environment. Doc. Dr.-Ing. Mirko Blagojevic added that the basic task is to define courses methodology which will be applicable to all universities. Prof. Dr.-Ing. Dušan Stamenković reminded that industry in Partner Countries is in very difficult situation, and contribution to better environment and recovery of the industry could be education of engineers in field of Product Development. After discussion, coordinator opened the last topic of the meeting.

Dipl.-Ing. Milan Banić started with the third presentation about Work Package 4. He presented goal and target group of this WP, as well as the budget for its realization. He said that education of the teachers is one of the main Tempus priority for West Balkan countries. After that, planned activities in frame of this work package are presented and explained, as well as their position in the work plan. After presentation was a discussion where Participants clarify difference between College education model in Serbian and Bosnia and Herzegovina, After short discussion about current obligations and responsibilities, the IPM made a decision that all partners have to send to coordinator the list of participants for realization of the project. It was concluded that is first step to form work groups for every work package, make action plan and realize the project activities in accordance with that. Prof. Dr.-Ing. Vojislav Miltenović thanked all present participants and closed the meeting of IPM.
