



Student organizations rating of curriculums modernised within TEMPUS IPROD Project

On the basis of detailed analysis of FME BU book of subjects (containing description of all courses), teaching materials and exams timetable, and also in anonymous consultation with numerous colleagues attending subjects modernised by TEMPUS IPROD Programme, we made the following conclusions:

1. Students of Faculty of Mechanical Engineering at University of Belgrade are very pleased with new curriculums improvements – for all analysed subjects, especially with attention given to the relevant EU technical legislation and thorough elaboration of Product Development fundamentals;
2. Ratio between practical and theoretical work is optimal for all modernised subjects and practical lectures follows theoretical systematically and gradually – further explaining scope of particular lecture;
3. Student practice programmes, realised within modernised courses, give students a great opportunity to get involved in everyday work of accredited laboratories and institutions dealing with the technical legislation in Republic of Serbia. Furthermore, during study visits students get a chance to establish connection with employees of visited institutions – which could be very significant for their future professional carrier;
4. The timetable of subject's exams is adjusted to student's needs - allowing them to plan examination according to their personal responsibilities and obligations.
5. Students are especially pleased that modernised curriculums provide them with equal knowledge like well-known European Universities, providing them with competitiveness to their European colleagues.
